They sponsored the Booster Bar sale which successfully started our class treasury. One memorable event in that year was the Belmont Invitational in which our freshman basketball team placed third in the city.

The main fund-raising project of our sophomore year was the doormat sale. Mr. Binkley, sophomore class advisor, and the class officers organized the project and worked hard to make it successful. The sale helped to finance our Freshman-Sophomore dance, "A Night in New Orleans."

As juniors we received the privileged title "upper classmen," and with it came the problem of how to make money for the prom. Led by Mrs. Peckham and Mr. Ashworth, class advisors, and the class officers, we sold directories, basketball programs, and sponsored Fairview Hockey Night at Hara Arena. The profit from these projects and the junior class play, The Best Laid Plans, made it possible for the junior class to present our prom "A Night in Tahiti" at Wampler's Ball Room on June 2, 1967.

At last we were seniors. We had the distinction of being the first graduating class to use the new addition, and for the first time, the juniors and seniors combined efforts to present a play, The Man Who Came to Dinner. Under the guidance of the class officers and Miss Nielsen, our advisor, we raised money for the farewell gift to the school. Our senior year was filled with serious decisions too, but we have profited immeasurably and are now prepared for new experiences.

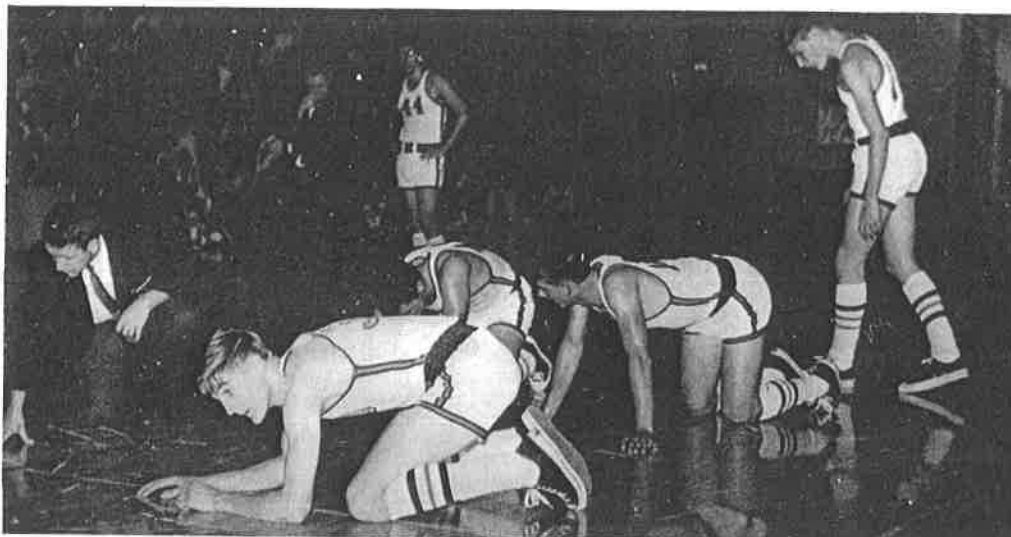

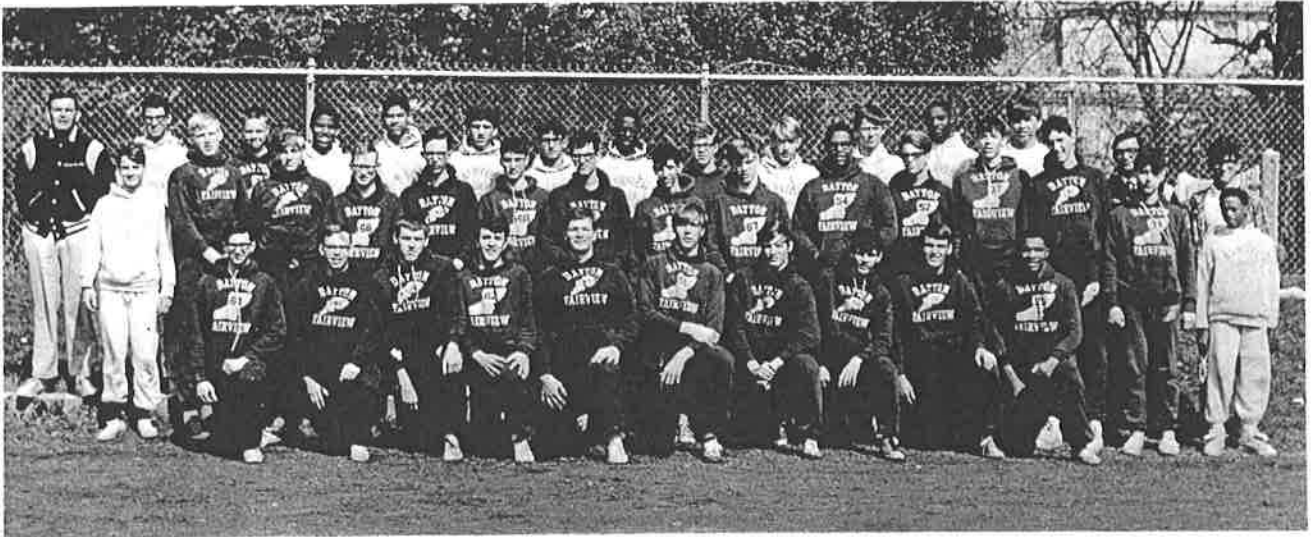

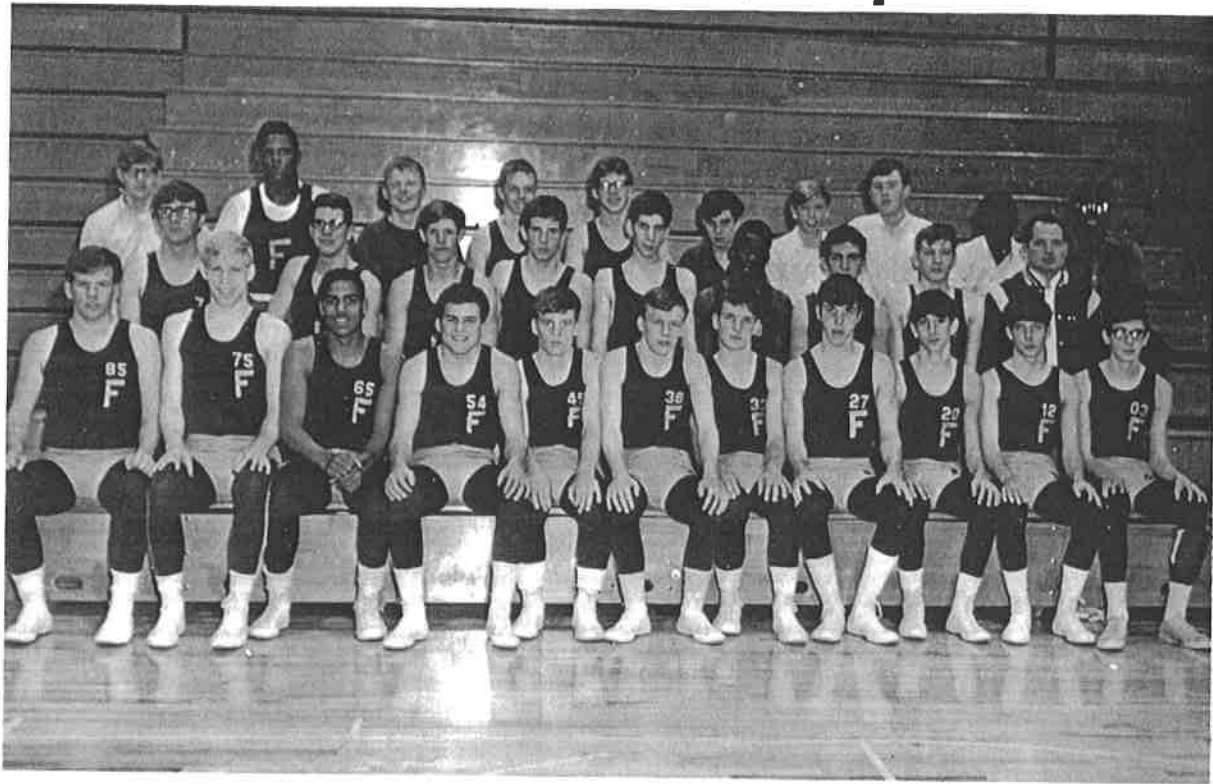

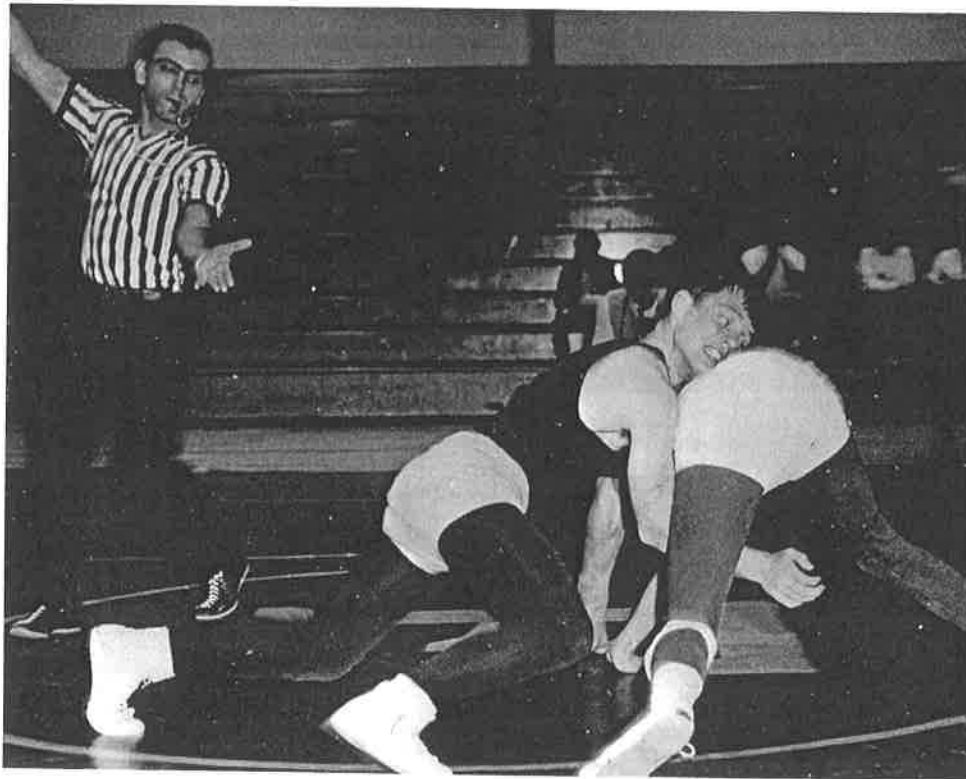

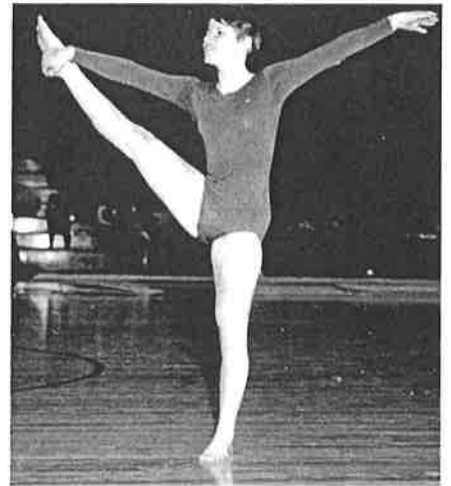

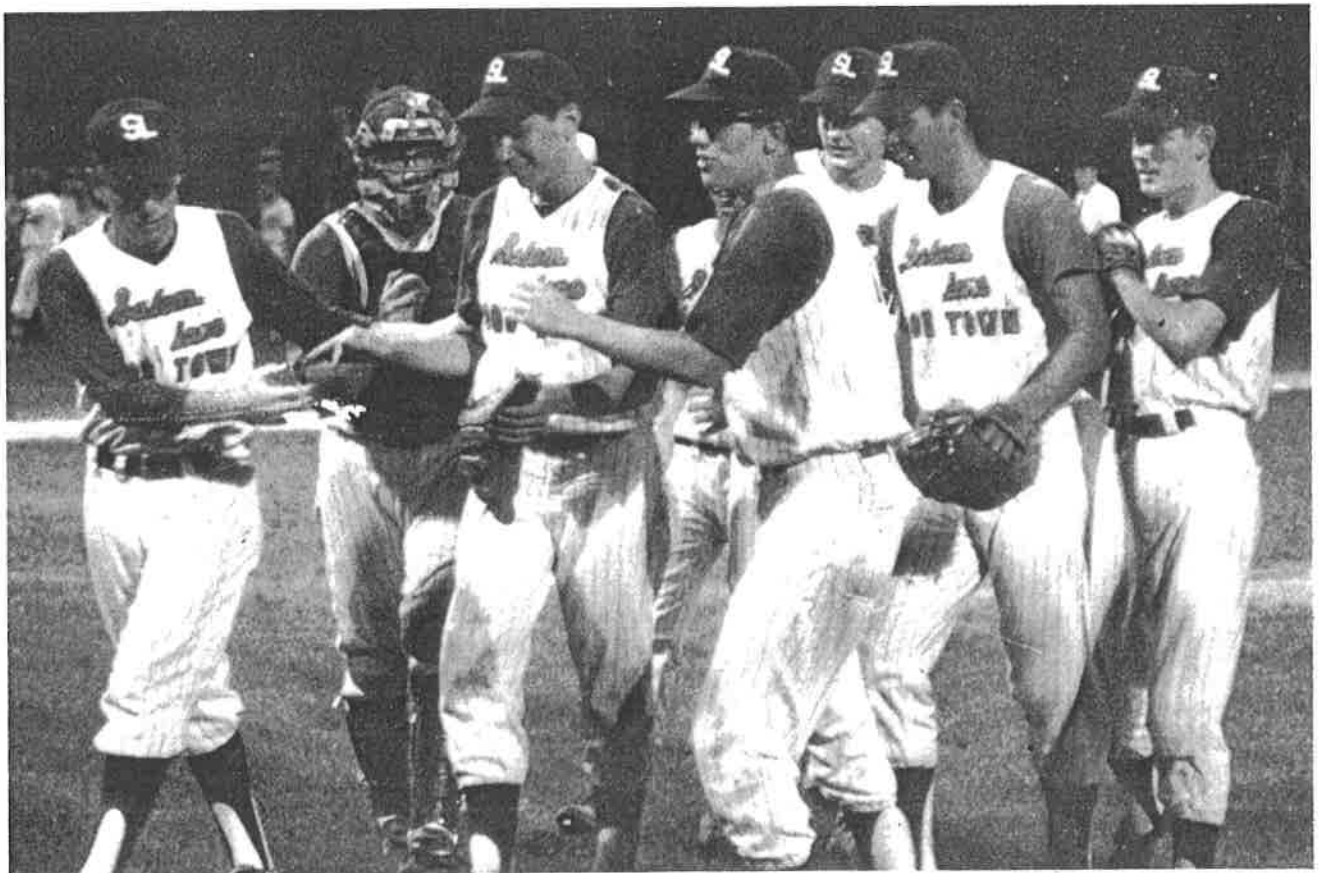

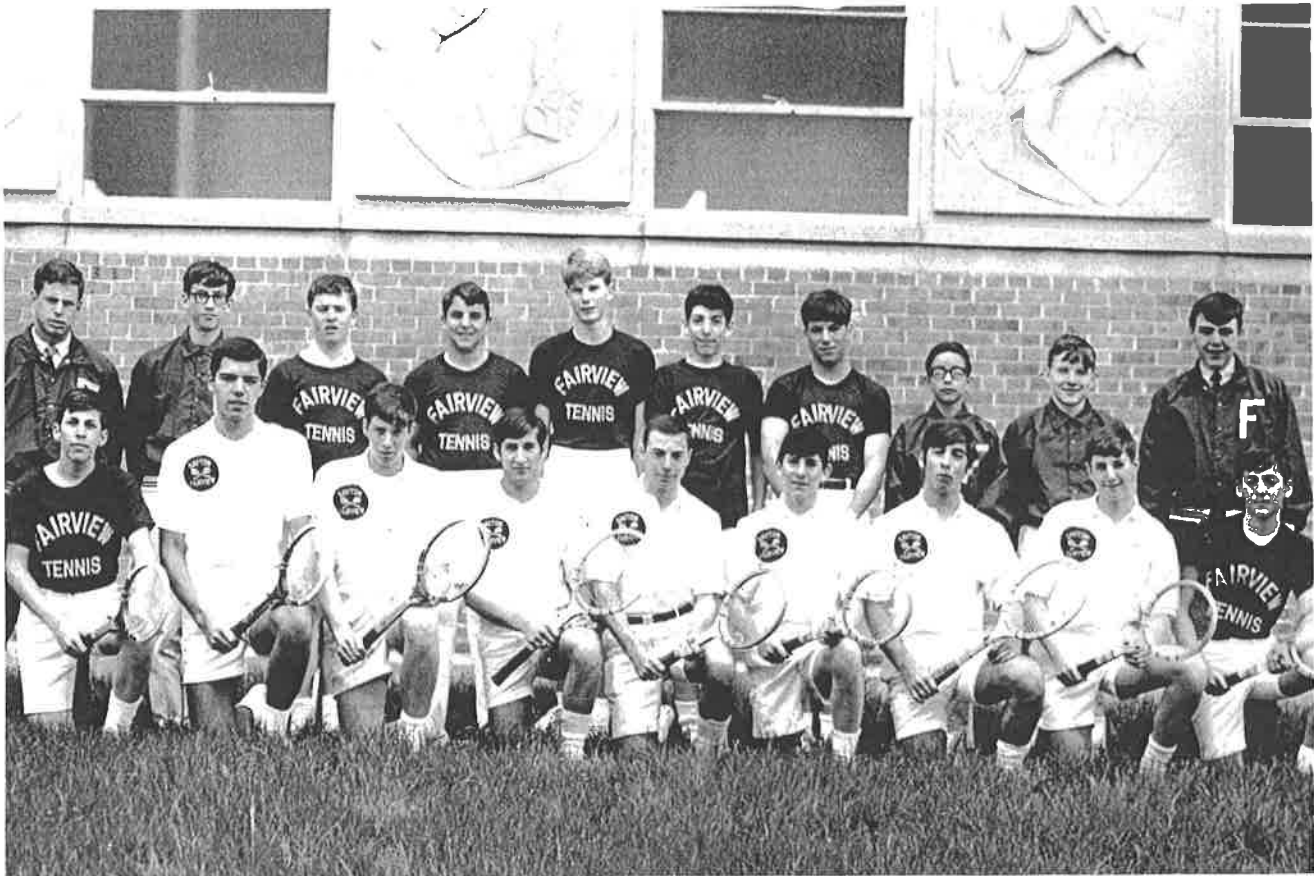
